## ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS VICTORIA

### General Rules and Conditions

1. The Victorian Arabian Championships is conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations for the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd. Competitors are responsible for becoming familiar with all sections of these rules as they form a part of the conditions of Entry for this show. Copies of the **2014** rules can be obtained through the AHSA Ltd or downloaded from <http://www.ahsa.asn.au/rulebook.html>

Unregistered horses will be accepted at close of entry but will not be catalogued. It is up to the **owner** to prove to the show committee that the horse is registered prior to the class and provide the exhibit's registration number. In the event that no proof is forthcoming the exhibit will not be eligible for competition and the entry fees will be forfeited.

### Conditions of Entry

2. The show committee shall have the power without assigning any reasons to:

- Reject or cancel any entry at any time.
- Cancel any event or class.
- Order the removal of any exhibitor from the showgrounds.
- Transfer an exhibit or exhibitor from any class to any other class.
- Change the running order of classes in the event of obvious clashes.
- If there are insufficient/sufficient numbers, classes may be combined or divided at the discretion of the ACV Committee.
- Youth exhibitors to be 17 years and under.
- Stallions and colts must be handled and ridden by persons 18 years and over.
- All riders under 18 years must wear an Australian Safety Approved Riding.
- Helmet; this rule also applies to the costume class.
- All ridden horses must be 3 years and over.
- Any horse or pony that causes interference to another exhibit may be asked to retire from the event.

### **NO SMOKING IS PERMITTED IN THE INDOOR ARENA COMPLEX, STABLES AND CATTLE PAVILIONS.**

- NO GLASS IS ALLOWED in the Indoor Arena Complex.
- No straw or hay is allowed in the Indoor Arena Complex.
- All emergency exits must be kept free from obstructions.

**Camping is permitted only in approved areas and campsite fees are compulsory.**

**No camping or parking of vehicles or floats is permitted around the stable areas.**

**Strictly No horses allowed in camping areas.**

**Nonstabled exhibits are to stay in the bitchumen carpark for the duration of the show**

Access to all fire hose reels and extinguishers must be maintained at all times. A 10 metre clear access to all fire hydrants on site must be maintained.

### **Protests and Appeals**

A Protests and Appeals Committee will be appointed prior to the show. All protests must be made in writing and a fee of \$50.00 must accompany each protest. This fee will be refunded unless the protest is deemed frivolous. Protests must be lodged within the hour of the class or event taking place.

### **Exhibitor Advice**

Exhibitors will be notified by mail approximately 10 days prior to the show. Advice will be given regarding stable allocation together with a rough timetable. Entries on the day may affect those times.

### **The Committee Accepts No Responsibility**

It is the policy of the Committee to see all due care is taken to protect property, but the Committee shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of defect, accident, negligence, however arising.

### **Awards**

Champion, Reserve Champion, Top 5, unless otherwise stated. Prizes for all Champions.

**ENTRIES - Emailed or faxed entries will not be processed unless payment has been received and is a complete entry (entry form & registrations). No exception.**

**INSURANCE – The Registered Participant Application must be completed by any person who is not a member of AHSA Ltd.**

**Entry fees will not be refunded once the entry has been accepted regardless of the reason. In some instances, a substitute horse may be brought in place of an unregistered or scratched horse by prior arrangement with the Secretary. A Vet Certificate will be required. Do not ask for a refund if these conditions cannot be met.**

**Amateur Owner Classes (Halter and Ridden)**

Must hold an Amateur Owner card as issued by the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited.

**Amateur Owner Novice** Open to Purebred and Derivative horses who have **not** won an Amateur Owner class at 'A' Class level at time of entries closing. Applies to both Saddle and Halter classes.

**The Debut Class – Novice Ridden**

Open to Purebred and Derivative horses who have **not** won at 'A' Class level at time of entries closing. Horses must be shown in a Snaffle bit. A hacking cane or whip is permitted. Spurs are optional. One horse/one rider only. The horse will be judged on quality, manners and paces. **The winner is eligible for the relevant Supreme Ridden.**

**Newcomers Class** will not have competed in a previous season under Saddle. Performance qualifications are not required and entry is open regardless of prior placing's. A Snaffle bit is compulsory. Whip, cane and spurs are optional.

**Half Arabian Jackpot** - A halter class for Derivatives either by a Registered Purebred Stallion or out of a Registered Purebred Mare.

**Prize money** for the **Newcomer, The Debut** and the **Half Arabian Jackpot Classes** will be made of the following from 65% of entries. Champion - 30% Reserve Champion - 20% Top 5 placing 5% each (3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> in Jackpot)

**The "Sue Kavanagh Memorial Trophy Award"**

Open to registered Purebreds and Derivatives (stallions, mares & geldings, aged 3 years and over). To be judged in two sections - Firstly as a halter exhibit, Secondly under saddle, if selected as a finalist. The horse is to be both ridden and shown at Halter by the same person. There shall be no equal placing.

**Previous horses that have won this event are ineligible to compete again.**

**Limit of two horses per rider / handler.**

Prize money for Sue Kavanagh will be made of the following from 65% of entries.

1st - 35%, 2nd 20% and 3rd and 4th 5%

**Any person (spectator or competitor) causing annoyance by loud comments on Judges' decisions or by unseemly conduct or by insulting behaviour will, after being cautioned, be named over the Public Address system. Should the unacceptable behaviour persist, forfeiture of any awards already gained and denial of further participation at this or any future VAHA event may result.**

## NON-PRO DECLARATION

(Effective 1st August 2014)

### Definition of a Non-Pro

A non-pro is one who, regardless of his/her equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, in the past three years has not directly or indirectly accepted as payment, goods or money for services usually provided by a professional in the areas of breaking, riding, training, schooling, driving, halter preparation, showing in halter or under saddle.

The following activities shall not affect the Non-Pro status of a person who is otherwise qualified;

- a) The writing of books
- b) Accepting remuneration for judging or stewarding
- c) Speaking at workshops, clinics, seminars or training days in a voluntary capacity where they do not accept a fee for their services.
- d) Receiving prize money or goods as services.
- e) Having the occupation of farrier, veterinarian, stable hand or groom.
- f) Owning or operating a saddlery, stud or breeding farm or boarding stables.

Spouses and immediate family of a trainer are also able to be registered as a Non-Pro, providing they are not involved with any of the above listed activities with horses where the trainer is being paid.

**INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION**  
Effective 1st May 2014

1. **MEMBERSHIP YEAR** - This covers the period 1st January to 31st December.
2. **PART YEAR MEMBERSHIP** - The Society's Articles of Association allow for a reduced fee for those persons who are elected as members for the first time between the period of 1st July to 31st December in any year. Applicants for membership which are received by the Society from 1st July until 30th November each year will qualify for this reduced fee.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious INJURY or DEATH may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.



I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.

I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this event.

I agree to follow the directions of any event organiser or official and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of any organiser or official can result in the CANCELLATION of my participation in the event and my immediate removal from my horse NO MATTER where that may occur. I further agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this show and the official Rule Book of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia. I understand that any such non-compliance may result in injury, death and/or permanent disability and I agree to indemnify the Releasees against all claims made by any person as a result of my failure to comply.

I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd and/or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.

I understand that due to diseases such as equine influenza, the Department of Primary Industries, or other state or commonwealth government bodies may restrict or prevent the movement of horses, vehicles and personnel for a time period, otherwise known as a "standstill".
